Saint Louis Zoo Rules and Policies

The following are prohibited for the safety and welfare of our animals and guests:

- > The use of tobacco products, including e-cigarettes
- Dogs or other pets (service animals are permitted, except in the Children's Zoo goat yard, Antelope House and Cypress Swamp). Dogs whose sole function is to provide comfort or emotional support do not qualify as service animals under the Americans with Disabilities Act and are not permitted inside the Zoo.
- Feeding the animals
- Entering non-public areas
- Firearms and weapons (even if you blades or scooters have a concealed Lasers carry endorsement)
- Balloons Bicycles (racks are available at entrances)
- > Drones
- > Wearing a costume or mask if over 13 years of age

> Segways, hoverboards

> Skates, skateboards, roller

> Glass bottles

Please note the following policies:

- > Children under age 14 must be accompanied by an adult or have an adult chaperone present at the Zoo (field trips, etc.).
- Family-friendly attire is required (no profanity or graphic images). Shirt and shoes must be worn. Swimsuits are prohibited with the exception for children in the water-play area of the Children's Zoo.
- The Zoo may take photographs of your party during your visit today. These photos may be used by the Zoo for both internal and public publications, including the Zoo website and social media.
- Personal video and photography are permitted. provided they don't interrupt the visitor experience for others.
- Student/commercial filming must be approved by the Zoo's Public Relations Department in advance.
- Distribution of any advertisements, handbills, products, or solicitation of funds or pledges of contributions within Zoo property is prohibited.
- Strollers and other personal belongings are left unattended at the owner's risk.
